a Baker Model "J" Retrievable Dual String Packer Gulf Oil Corporation's

Arnott-Ramsay "F"

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Lea County, New Mexico

That said patcher was set at a depth of 5495 feet,
said depth measurement being taken by **Welex**.

That the purpose of setting the packer was to prevent the commingling of the oil and gas, and that below the packer and above the stratum aquifer the packer was properly set and it did, as a matter of fact, seal off the gravel zone between the two strata in such manner as that it never allowed a seepage of fluid from a seal in the gravel zone. That the packer was set so as to prevent fluid from a stratum above the packer. That this was done in a safe and absolutely correct manner when it was set in the gravel zone above the packer.
