DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Plugged 7" Casing from 3350 to 3275' with 15 Sacks Cement and shot off 7" Casing at 2500' and recovered a total of 86 Jts 2551' of 7" Casing and Plugged 9 5/8" Casing from 1419' to 1300' with 25 Sacks Cement and took hold of 9 5/8" Casing and collar pulled off and had welder cut off 12 1/2" Braden Head and did not recover any 9 5/8" Casing, leaving all of the 12 1/2" surface Pipe in hole which was 135'. Then filled Hole with mud placing a 10 Sack Cement Cap on top of mud in hole with a piece of 4" Pipe 5' high as a marker in center of cement cap.
