Released: Approximately 35 B/PW; Recovered: 34 B/PW.

Cause of the release was from a psi valve plug on a knockout that broke. Vacuum truck(s) were called and recovered 34 bbls of the 35 bbls of released produced water. The remaining one (1) bbl of produced water is entrained within the gravel and will be removed when the gravel is removed. The removed gravel will be disposed at an NMOCD approved facility. The valve was repaired. This A Form C-141 with complete information will be submitted.
