At 9:15 am, Operator arrived onsite and observed a stuffing box release. Approximately 11 gallons of oil was released in an overspray.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The overspray affected a 105 ft x 132 ft area off the NW side of location as well as a 66 ft x 60 ft area off the E side of location. The well was shut-in pending repairs to the stuffing box. An initial light scrape was performed on location. Samples were taken and are currently being assessed by Vertex.
