The heater treater is out of service. A tank was equalizing when the FWKO dumped oil to the tanks the excess pressure caused oil to overflow from the thief hatch. The tanks will be switched before equalizing while the heater treater is out of service.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

All of the fluid remained inside of the lined containment. A final inspection has been conducted regarding the clean-up efforts made at the above mentioned lined facility. Free fluids were removed and if present the impacted gravel was removed from the liner and taken to a NMOCD approved disposal facility. The liner was inspected for damage and found to have liner integrity to contain free fluids.
