SUBSEQUENT REPORT: Pull Retrievable Plug between 1st & 2nd Bone Spring Sands and Commingle Both Sets of Bone Spring Perfs

A Service Rig was moved onto location on Friday 10/12/12. Rods & tubing were removed from the well on 10/15/12. 34 feet of sand was bailed off the RBP at 9,270 and the plug released and pulled on 10/16/12. Tubing was rerun & set below the 2nd Bone Spring and the well returned to production on 10/17/12. The well is now producing from the 2nd Bone Spring perforations between 9532-9598 and the 1st Bone Spring perforations between 9032 - 9054'.
