I think you need some more time off or you're going to be in a rubber room soon. And speaking of bouncing around, this email is going to cover a couple of topics that have come up with your recent emails.

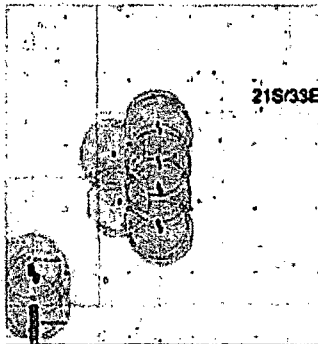
I've attached my own sketch of what I think you described in your "short" story about the DIs in 21S-33E. In my drawing, the maroon-colored circles represent the ½ mile impacts from the islands. The yellow shading represents the east expansion leases. The blue-colored islands are from what I believe is your latest proposal for DIs in the neighborhood.

Based on the premise that I'm understanding your proposal correctly, I have no objections to the DIs in 21S-33E. As you can see, they don't impact our East Expansion Leases, and that's our main concern.
