On November 12, 2007, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed a field examination of the abandoned SEMU No. 114, located 810' FNL and 2130' FWL in Section 29, T. 20 S., R. 38 E., Lea County, New Mexico.

All final abandonment requirements have been met except for vegetative growth (20%) established evenly across the location. The BLM will continue to monitor the surface restoration of this abandoned well site.
