Well sign, fencing, and barbed wire on location. 4 secondary power poles starting on southeast corner of location running to the east to primary line. NEED TO REMOVE ANCHOR, SIGN, AND FENCING MATERIAL. NEED TO CONTACT LEA COUNTY ELECTRIC COOP (LCEC) AND REQUEST REMOVAL OF POLES AND POWER LINES. NEED TO ATTACH A COPY OF THE CORRESPONDENCE WITH LCEC TO A C-103 REQUEST FOR FINAL INSPECTION OF PLUGGED WELL AFTER ANCHORS AND FENCING HAVE BEEN REMOVED.
