Superior Federal #5 Sec. 25-T19S-R34E Lea County, New Mexico #5 Flowline Leak

Incident No.: nPRS0521739386

A flow line leak occurred on 7-18-05 releasing 80 BW and 2 BO. On inspection on 5-29-15 showed that the vegetation has recovered except for areas that are crusted with weathered oil. Analysis indicates Chloride at 224-416 mg/kg, GRO C6-C10 <10-50 and DRO C10-C28 58-353. The following procedure is to be used on the remaining "crusted areas" that are not supporting vegetation.

- 1. Broadcast granular fertilizer at the rate of 50 lbs./1000 ft² of 13-13-13 fertilizer or equivalent.
- 2. Till in fertilizer and breakup crust to a depth of 6" to 12".
- Reseed with BLM seed mixture #2 at the rate of .25 lbs./1000 ft². Drill or rake to cover seeds. Apply before July 1, 2015.
- 4. AT 30-60-90 day periods apply fertilizer at the rate of 5 lbs./1000 ft² of 13-13-13 fertilizer or equivalent.
- 5. Monitor progress and reevaluate in the spring of 2016.

The Superior Federal #5 was P & A'd this spring. The caliche has been removed, the location and road ripped and the road and location have been reseeded. The leak area is just off the northeast corner of the old location.
