In most cases this means returning the land to a condition approximating or equal to that which existed prior to the disturbance. Instead, the operator must achieve the short-term stability, visual, hydrological, and productivity objectives of the surface management agency and take steps necessary to ensure that long-term objectives will be reached through natural processes.
