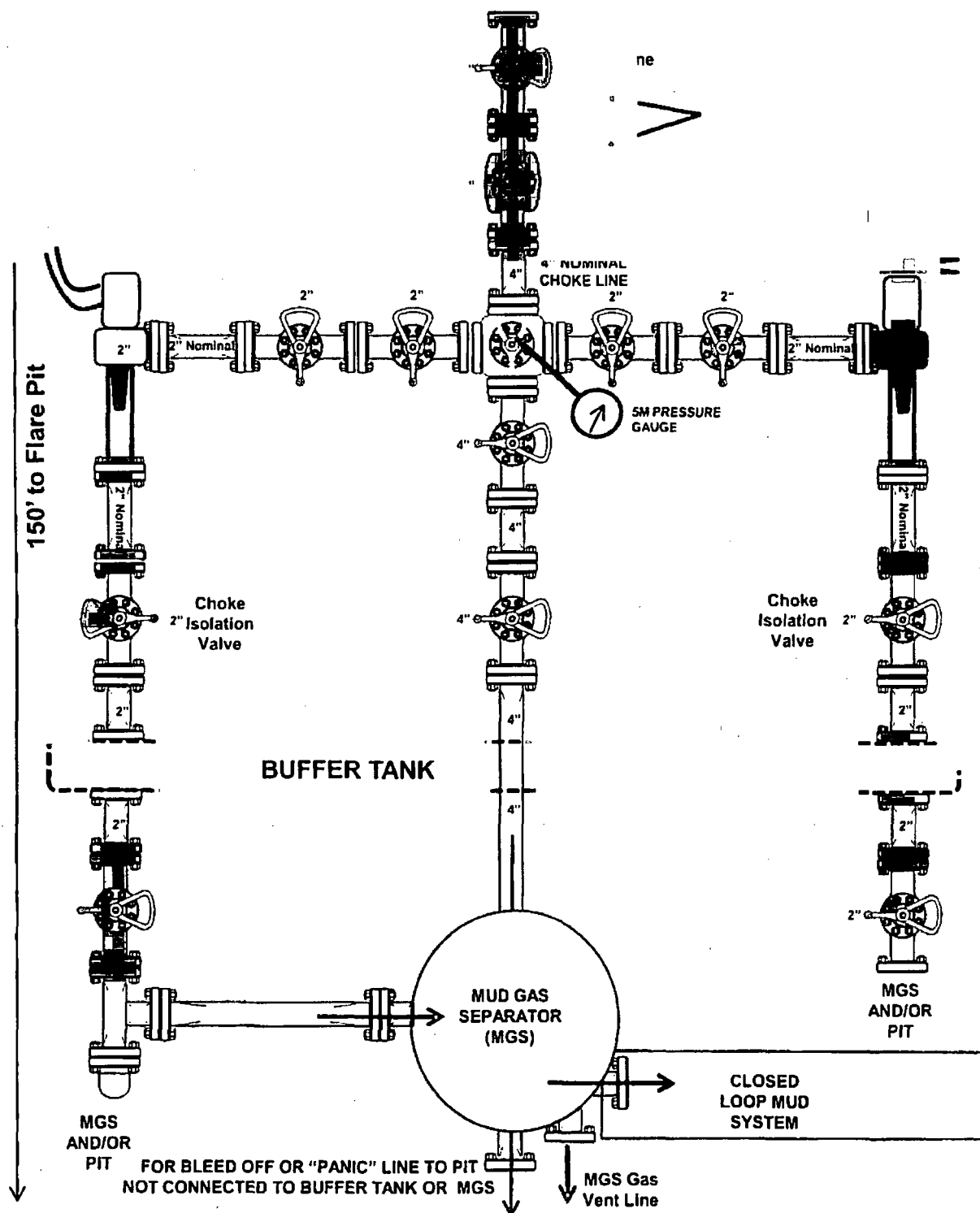

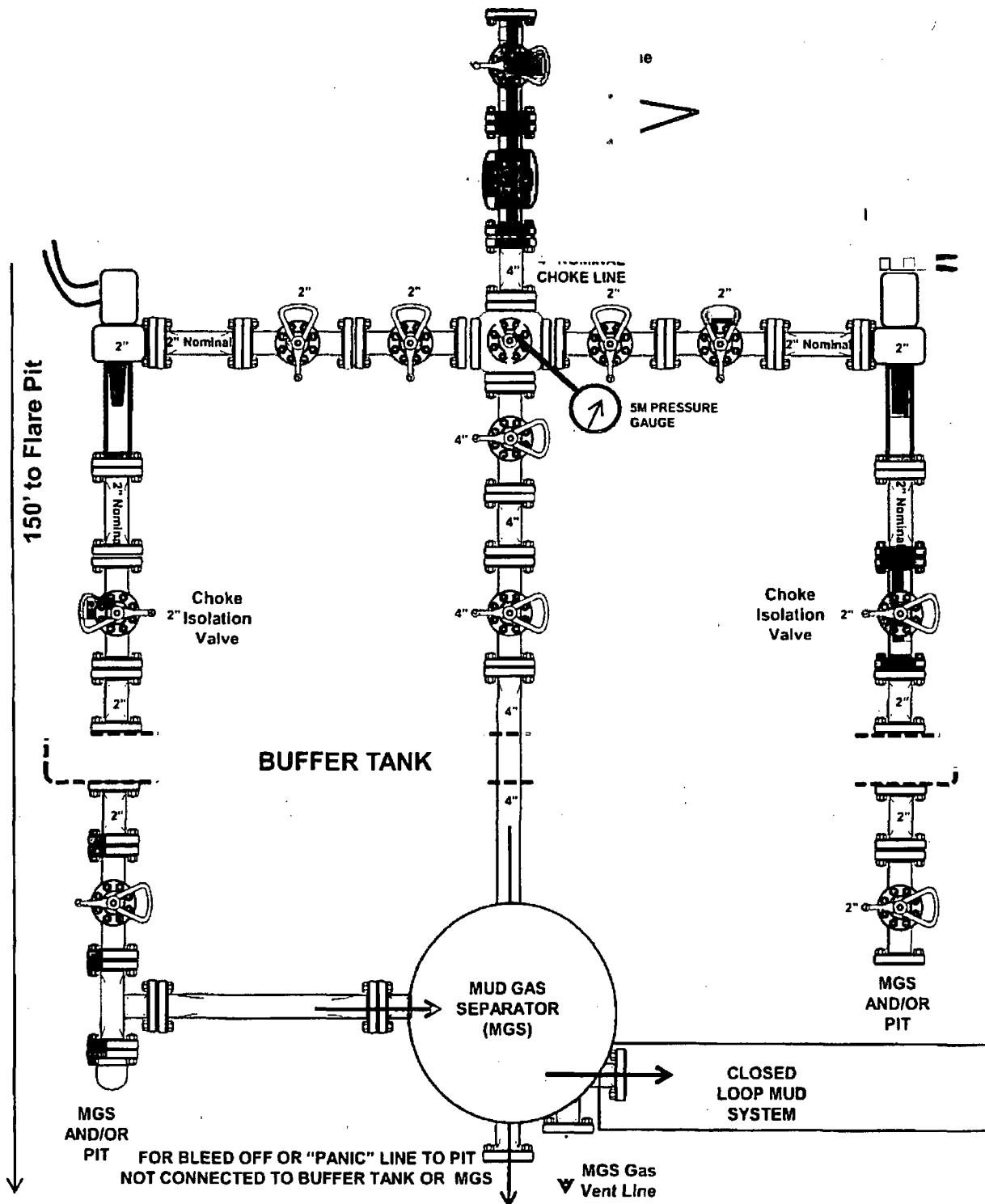

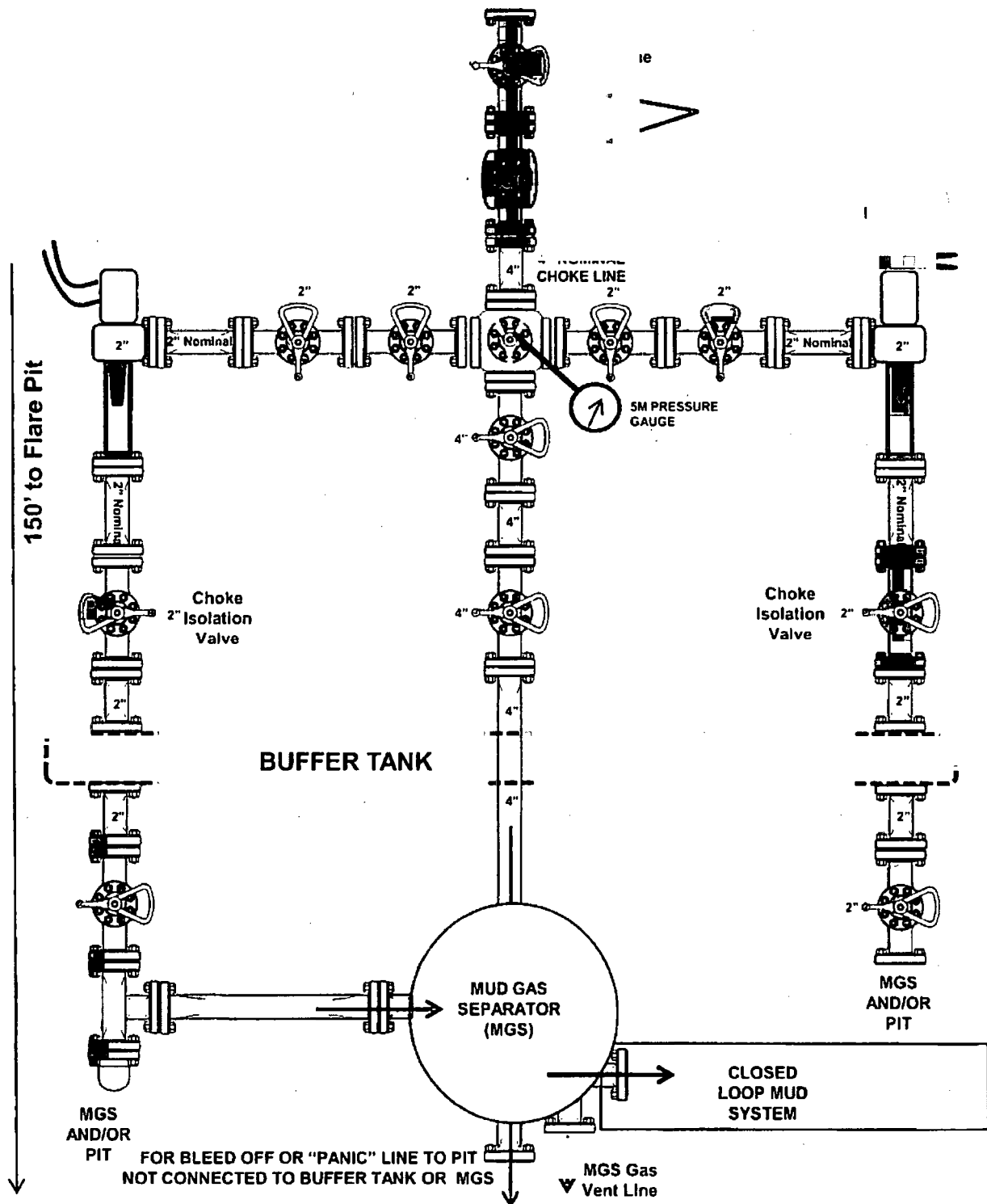


# 10M CHOKE MANIFOLD CONFIGURATION

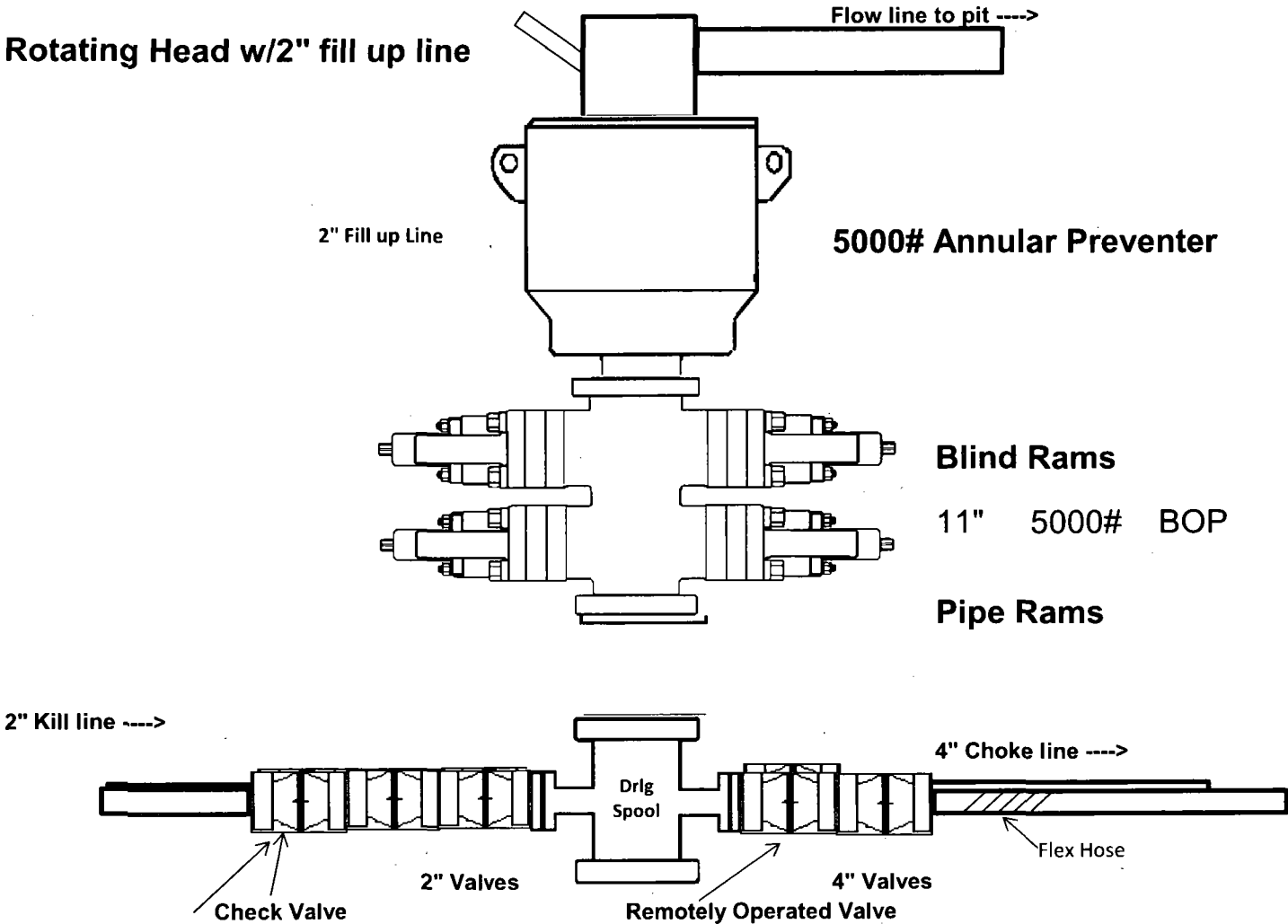

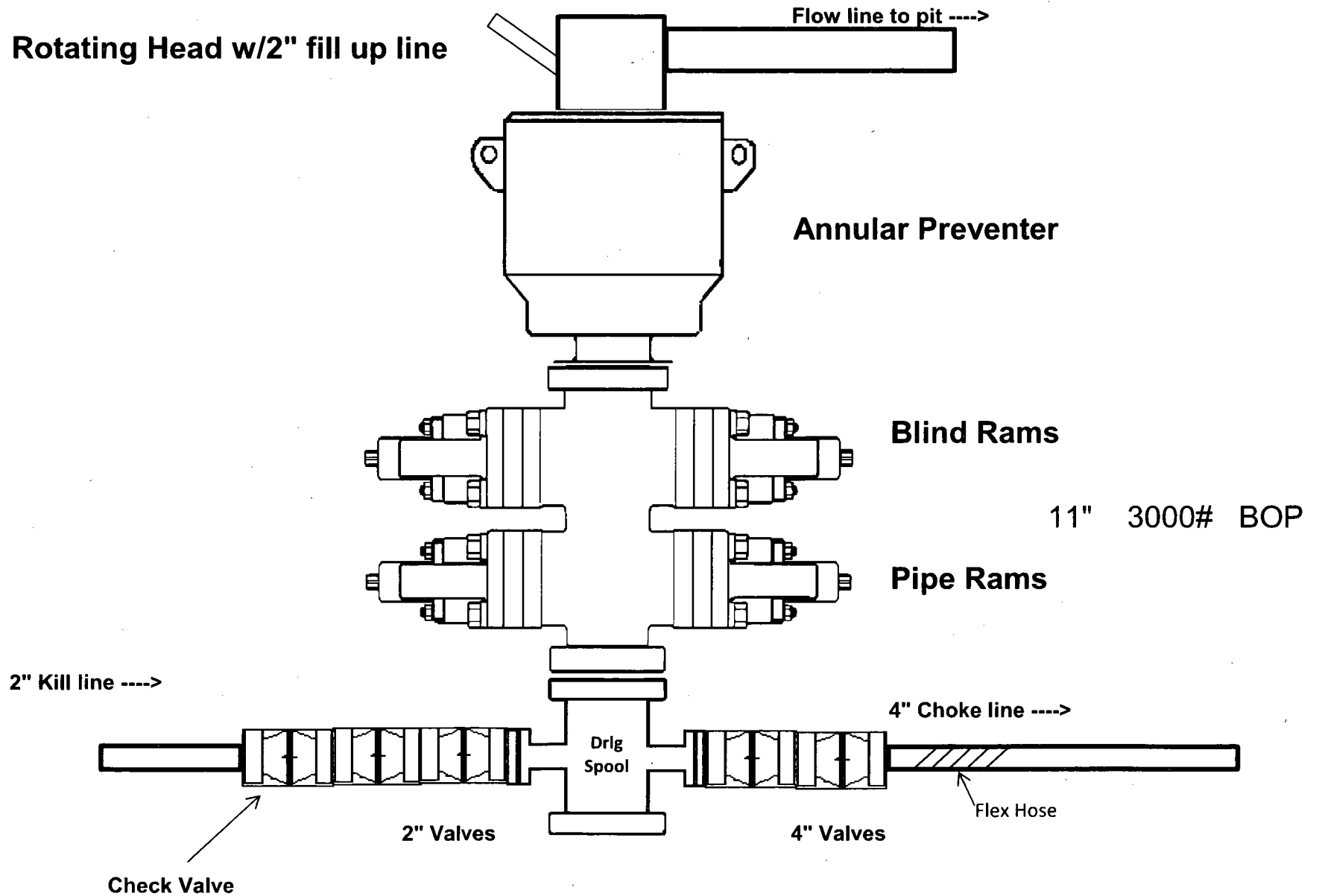

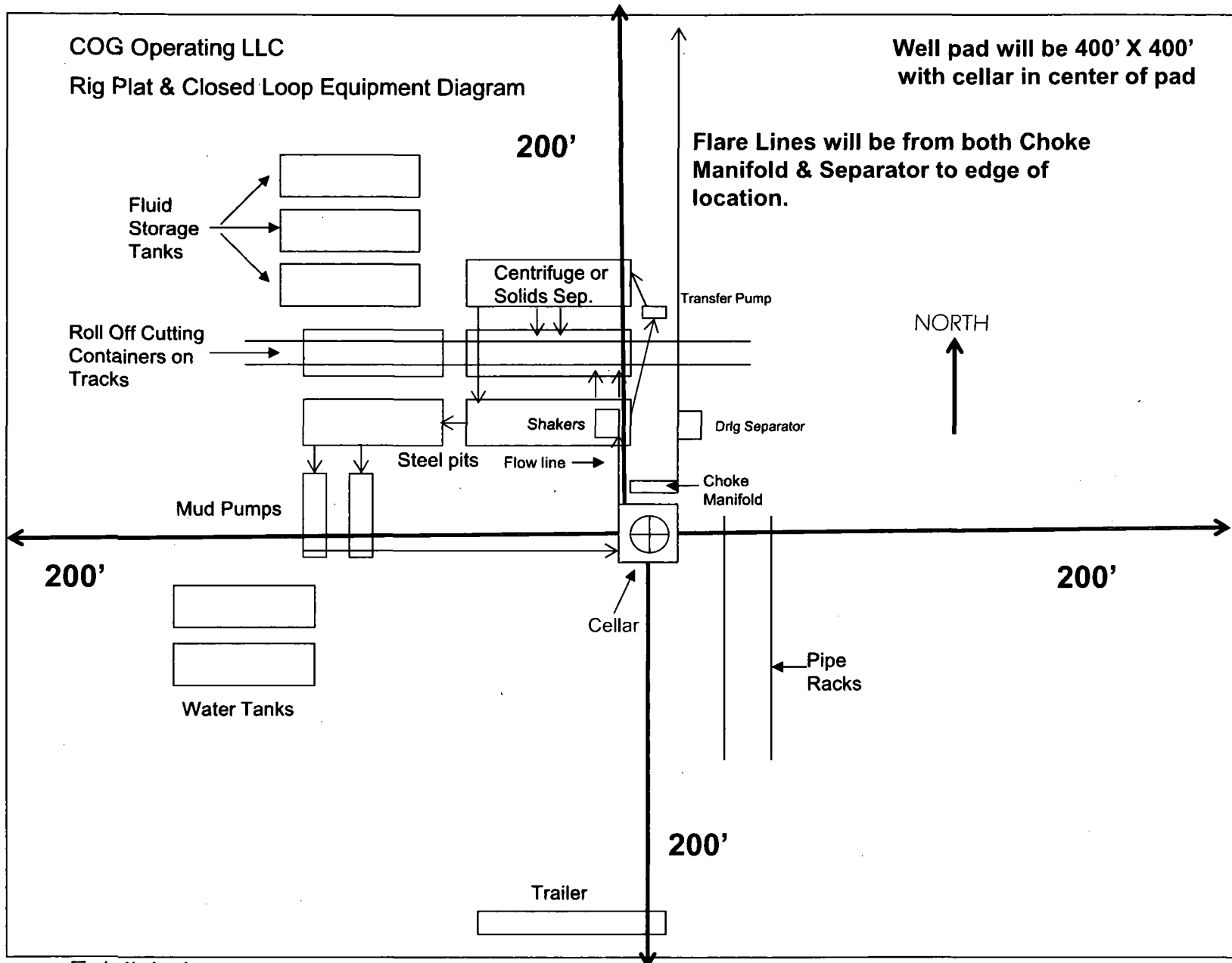
