Dear Mr. Chance,

You were duly informed of the termination of the New Mexico State Land Office (NMSLO) Salt Water Disposal Easement (SW-0093-2) permitting the use of the above referenced well located on state trust land, by a certified letter from the NMSLO dated September 25, 2017. That same letter contained instructions to you to:

- 1. Plug and abandon the well. This must be done according to the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD).
 - 2. Remove all equipment on site used for the disposal of salt water.
 - 3. Properly reclaim the well location.
 - 4. Apply to the NMSLO for a Right of Entry Permit so that the above work may be accomplished. Two original copies of such permit were enclosed with the further instruction that you were to sign, date and notarize both copies and return them to the NMSLO.

To date none of the above items have been accomplished by you.

You must immediately contact the NMSLO and apprise us of your schedule for the completion of the tasks noted above. And, you must resolve the above issues with the NMSLO by June 15, 2018, otherwise NMSLO will consider pursuing criminal trespass or other enforcement options.
