The areas described aggregate 2,240.000 acres;

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the State of New Mexico, the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said lands with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the State of New Mexico, forever, and

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO THE UNITED STATES:

1. A right-of-way thereon for ditches and canals constructed by the authority of the United States. Act of August 30, 1890 (26 Stat. 391; 43 U.S.C. 945);
2. All mineral deposits in all of sec. 8 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. 17, T. 22 S., R. 33 E., NMPM, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove such deposits from the same under applicable law.

This patent is issued in lieu of Patent No. 30-85-0037 dated April 19, 1985, which has been cancelled because of an error in the mineral reservation.
