In order for the NMOCD to close the site, the inspector is asking for a written confirmation that the poles and wire belonging to the Cooperative will be removed.

It has become a more important issue, because the NMOCD is holding up issuance of a drilling permit for a well until the Buckeye location is properly documented as closing and being in progress for the final restoration – which includes the future removal of the power lines.

I would appreciate your help in forwarding this request to Ray or whomever might be able to help me with this. I can give any assurance needed to make sure that the Cooperative will be able to bill BTA for the costs that they are supposed to cover for this future work.
