11,060' - Total Depth; 9827' - Plugged Back Depth - Line. Run Temperature Survey - top of cement on outside of 5-1/2" casing at 6950', ratio of actual to calculated fill 81.7%. Run 2-3/8" O.D. K&B Tubing & a 4-3/4" bit & checked top of cement at 9700'. Tested casing & connections with 1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Washed out cement to 9827' & tested casing & connections with 1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Continued with completion operations.
