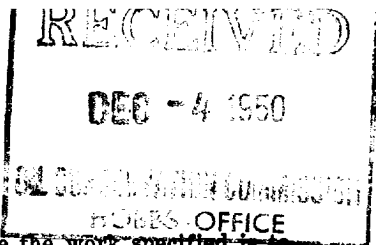

Drilled plug after squeezing with 50 sack HONCO cement; perforations at 9640 ft. Swabbed well dry; some cement apparently passed around Cal-seal plug or the plug broke down during squeeze. No fluid coming into hole. Plan to acidize with 1000 gals. using Dowell Pilet; pay from 9655 to 9659 ft.
