May 21, 1979: Moved in and installed on location 400 barrel frac fluid tank. Heavy rains in the area required the use of a caterpillar tractor to move in the 400 barrel tank and mounting equipment. The move in resulted in a considerable amount of damage to the road and location. Tank move in and installation work was conducted by Pate Trucking Co. of Denver City, Texas, under the supervision of Mr. Dean E. Wolf, Petroleum Engineer, Midland, Texas.

Road and location restoration work to be conducted at such time surface conditions are favorable.
