Ran 3078' of 5 1/2" 14# Seamless J-55 casing and set at 3080'. Cemented with 100 sacks of Neat. Temperature survey found the top of the cement at 2620'. Pipe and casing seat tested with 800 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement and both held OK.
