This well was formerly operated by John H. Trigg Company as the Trigg Federal "A" Well No. 1, and was plugged and abandoned by Trigg on 3-8-67.

ACTUAL RE-ENTRY PROCEDURE:

- Moved in WO rig and drilled out junk and cement.
- Moved WO rig out and moved drilling rig in - drilled out junk and cement and cleaned out hole to TD 13,572'.
- Ran 120 joints (4092') 4-1/2" OD x 13.04# N-80 K-3 hydril liner set at 13,437' - top 9345' (sealed off perforations at 9590-9718'). Circulated cement with 1000 sacks Class "C" 1:1 Fosmix, 2% gel, 3/4% CFR-2, 9# salt per sack. Plugged down at 7:30 p.m. Set liner packer, reversed out 200 sacks cement, WOC 20 hours.
- Acidized 13,437-13,572' open hole with 1000 gallons of 15% mud acid, 2100# at 3.5 BPM and started disposing of salt water. Date completed for injection - 1-30-69.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
