Spudded 3/26/61 & drilled 17-1/2" hole to 380' in redbeds. Cemented 13-3/8" - 48# emls. casing @ 378' w/350 ex. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hrs., pressure-tested casing w/500 psi for 30 min. - hold O. K.

Drilled 12-1/4" hole 380-1744'.

Drilled 11" hole 1744-4184' (approx. 80' into San Andres lime)

Ran 8-5/8" - 24 & 32# casing and cemented @ 4183' w/150 ex. regular on 4/3/61. WOC 36 hrs. Pressure-tested 8-5/8" casing w/1000 psi for 30 min. - no pressure drop. Drilling 7-7/8" hole ahead.

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
