DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 10:00 A.m. November 18, 1950, after 30 hours had elapsed since cementing 341 ft. of 13-3/8" with 300 sx of cement and circulating the cement to the surface, the casing was tested with 400 psi. 30 minutes later the pressure had dropped to 350 psi. After drilling 50' of solid cement water shut-off was tested with 350 psi. The pressure has dropped to 325 psi at the end of 30 minutes. This test was considered satisfactory and drilling has been resumed.
