Set at 361' and cemented with 400 ~~sz~~ 50-50 posmix A and regular, 2 1/2 gal. Plug down 9:05 p.m. August 16, 1957. Circulated 70 sacks. W.O.C. 25 hours and pressure tested with 600 psi for 30 min. Held O.K.
