We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: Size of Hole, Size of Casing, Weight Per Foot, New or Second Hand, Depth, Landed or Cemented, Sacks Cement. Rows include 17 1/4, 11, and 7 7/8 casing sizes with corresponding weights and depths.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 9600 feet.

Additional information: This will replace Form C - 101 filed on March 15, 1951, for Well No. 2 to be at this location as a 11500' test. Well No. 2 will be drilled in another location. Corrected form will be furnished in near future.

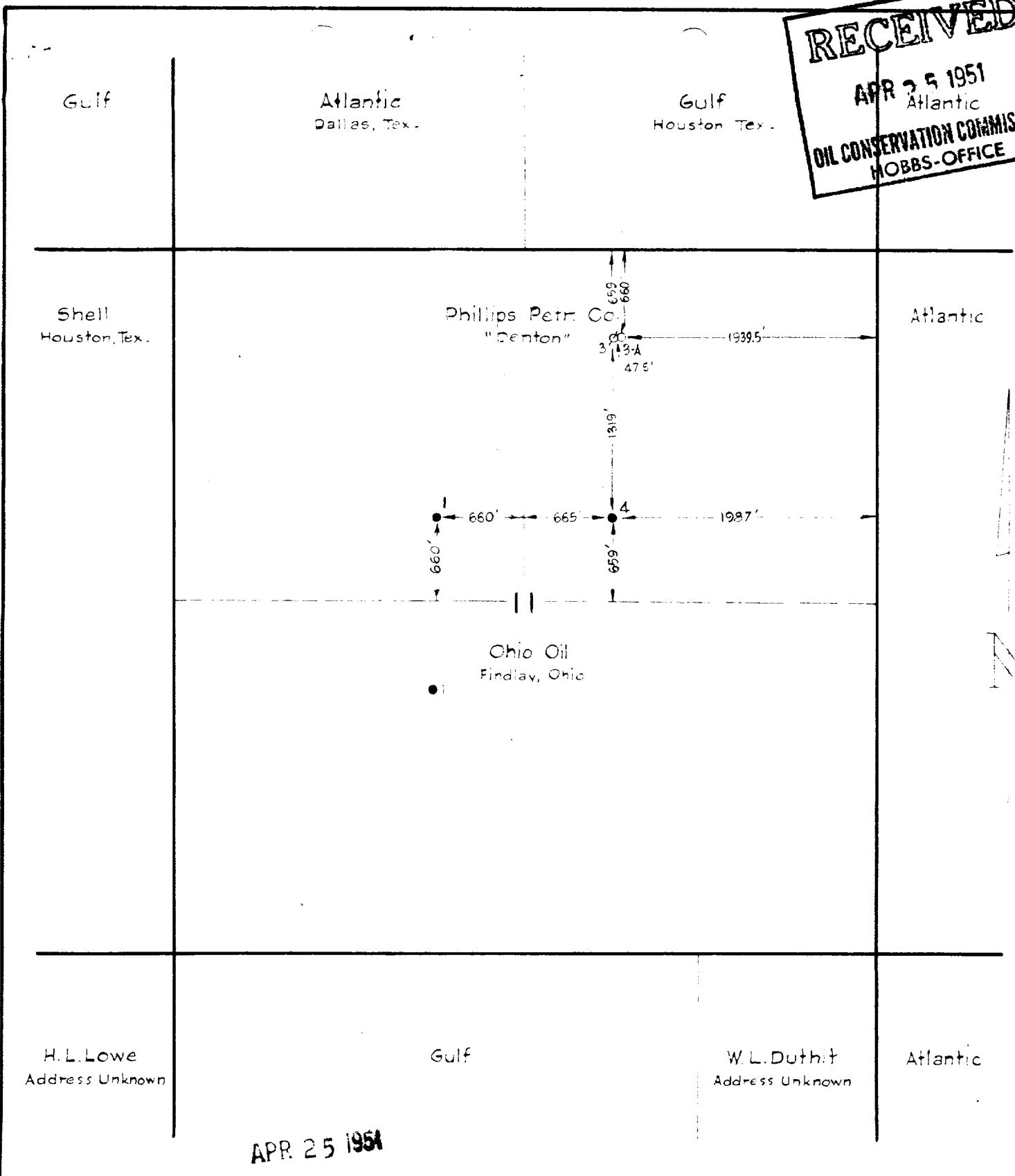
