We understand you are now the owner of certain wells in Lea County, New Mexico, described as:


1. NE/4 NW/4 of Section 9;
2. NE/4 NE/4 of Section 9;

All in Township 17 South, Range 34 East.

We have tested these wells from time to time to determine if there is sufficient casinghead gas production to justify connection to our gathering system. Our tests continue to show that the gas is too small to measure; consequently, we are unable to offer a market for your gas.

We shall continue to observe this production and if the situation should change, we shall be pleased to give further consideration to the connection of any available casinghead gas.
