4207' T.D. - 12-1/2" OD Csg set @ 210', 9-5/8" OD Csg set @ 2704' & 7" OD Csg set @ 3997'. As per State Form C-102, dated 12/22/53, set Baker Magnesium Bridging plug @ 3945'. Set Baker Retrievable Retainer at various depths & tested 7" OD csg for leak. Found leak in 7" OD csg between 1788' & 1810'. Cut 7" OD csg @ 2690'. Ran a total of 87 jts of 7" OD csg & 7" x 8-1/4" Bash-Ross Csg Bowl, set csg bowl @ 2690'. Tested 7" OD csg w/1500# - OK. Drilled Baker Magnesium Bridging Plug @ 3945' and washed from 3945' to bottom @ 4207'. Well continues to produce oil from Hobbs Pool.
