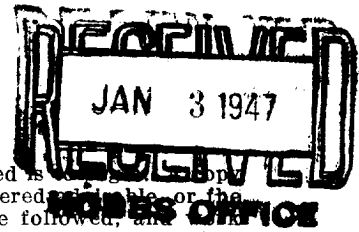

Standard Oil Co. of Texas, State 1-29, Well No. 4, in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 18S, R. 38E, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Field, Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

- 1. Deepen well approximately 40' to third zone in Hobbs pay.
2. Run 5-1/2" casing to total depth.
3. Cement 5-1/2" casing to surface.
4. Perforate opposite oil zones in Hobbs pay.
5. Perforate opposite upper gas zone 3964'-4020'.
6. Run tubing and set packer between oil and gas zones (Gas to be produced thru annulus to operate gas lift wells.)
