DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED  
 Was treated with 2000 gallons 50% Hydrochloric Acid Solution and 5 gallon #2 Nep Inhibitor by the Chemical Process Company. 58 barrels of oil were pumped in through the tubing followed by the 2000 gallons acid solution and then by 52 barrels oil pressure on casing 1200#, tubing 600# at begining and 3" was at close. production before-open 3,300 oil and 4,595,189 Cu. ft. Gas, oil Ratio 1390 production after 11,146 Oil and 15,000,000 Cubic feet gas, oil Ratio 1346.
