Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company B. H. Turner Tract 1 Well No. 30 in the Company or Operator Lease NH/A of Sec. 34, T. 18-S, R. 38-E, N. M. P. M., Bowers Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 1, 1949, at 6:00 p.m. 48 hours had elapsed since running 3202' of 5 1/8" casing set at 3191' and cemented with 800 sacks to be used as oil string. Cement was circulated to surface. Pipe and water shut off was tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before and after drilling cement plug. Both tests were satisfactory and operations were resumed.
