Pull rods and tubing, go back with tubing openended and set 15 sx plug across perforations and shoot 5 1/2" casing loose at approximately 2000' and run a 15 sx plug in stub of same. Then set with a 15 sx plug in bottom of 7-5/8" at 1735' and a 5 sx plug in top with a 4" marker 5' above the ground.
