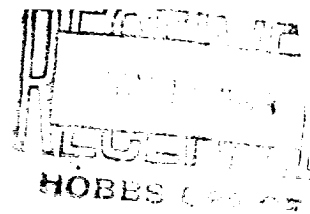

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 4272 - Lime - Plugged back with gravel 4269-72, ran 430 quarts SNG 4050 to 4268 (4" shells 230 qts. 4170-4268; 3" shells 200 qts. 4050-4170). Gravel 4035 to 4050. 7 sacks 60 min. Calseal 3974-4035. One Bolshevik cave catcher, 24 hour time bomb set for 10 AM. Hole loaded with 95 barrels oil. No kick or shot heard in shooter's phone. Oil flowed over drilling head for several minutes at 10:04 AM. Moved off spudder. Will drill out with care and watch for indication of spent shot. Now cleaning out.
