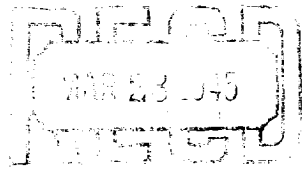

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

During February, 1945, the 2 3/8" OD tubing was pulled and reran with 10 - 2" EUE 10 Thd. 100# diff. Merla Type EM flow valves; tubing set at 4006'7". Valve spacing as follows: 947'2", 1191'2", 1437'5", 1681'3", 1927'5", 2169'9", 2412'7", 2655'8", 2899'5", and 3145'5".

Production before: Well averaged 35 bbls. oil and 20 bbls. water daily.

Production after: Flowed 48 bbls. oil and 25 bbls. water in 24 hours through 3/4" and 1/2" chokes wide open with outside gas from the Monument Gas System.
