Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was spudded March 14, 1956. A 12-1/4" hole was drilled to 350'. 8-5/8" 2 1/2 J-55 casing was cemented at 343' using 325 sacks of cement (50-50 Pozmix-Incor) w/2% @ 61. Cement was allowed to set 36 hours before resuming operations. The casing and cement job was tested to 600 psi and found to be O. K.
