FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was drilled to a depth of 3962' and was shot with 200 quarts Nitroglycerin from 3875-3962'. After shooting, the well scrubbed dry and no production was obtained. The well was then deepened to 4191' and was shot with 500 quarts Nitroglycerin from 3985' to 4185'. The well was cleaned out and scrubbed, recovering 100 barrels sulphur water. Permission is requested to plug and abandon this well according to rules and regulations as set out by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

We will pull what we can of the 5 1/2" casing, which we estimate will be approximately 1000'. We will set a 20-sack cement plug at 3854' which is the bottom of the 5 1/2" casing and also a 20-sack cement plug where the 5 1/2" is shot off and pulled. A 10-sack cement plug will be set in the surface pipe. A marker will be set at the abandoned location.
