Well was plugged back to 3855' with lead wool and calseal; a bridging plug was set at 3695' and cement was dump on top to 3690'.

5-1/2" casing was perforated from 3510' to 3625', and perforations were washed with 250 gallons of mud acid and 250 gallons of 15% regular acid. Well kicked off and flowed 232,000 CF of gas per day.
