Gentlemen:

The following is a report of lost oil on the Arnott Ramsay "C" Lease, Section 21, T-21, R-36, Eunice Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

On November 13, 1950, the flow line from the Arnott Ramsay "C" well No. 10 parted from contraction due to cold weather, and approximately 29 barrels of oil was lost. None of the oil could be recovered as the oil soaked into the ground and was then covered. The flow line was repaired.

On November 26, 1950, the dump valve on the separator stuck shut due to an excessive deposit of calcium carbonate, and approximately 126 barrels of oil went into the Phillips gas gathering line to the Phillips gasoline plant. None of this oil could be recovered. The dump valve was cleaned and is again in operating condition.
