#### DETAILS OF WORK

This well will be drilled to an approximate depth of 5000 feet, or a depth sufficient to adequately test the Delaware Sand formation. It will be drilled with rotary to top of Delaware Sand and cored to total depth. We will run 325' of 8 5/8" 24# casing and will circulate cement back to surface. We will run 4 1/2" OD 9.5# new casing to total depth, cement with approximately 250 sx to bring cement back to 3000 feet; pay section will then be perforated and treated if necessary.

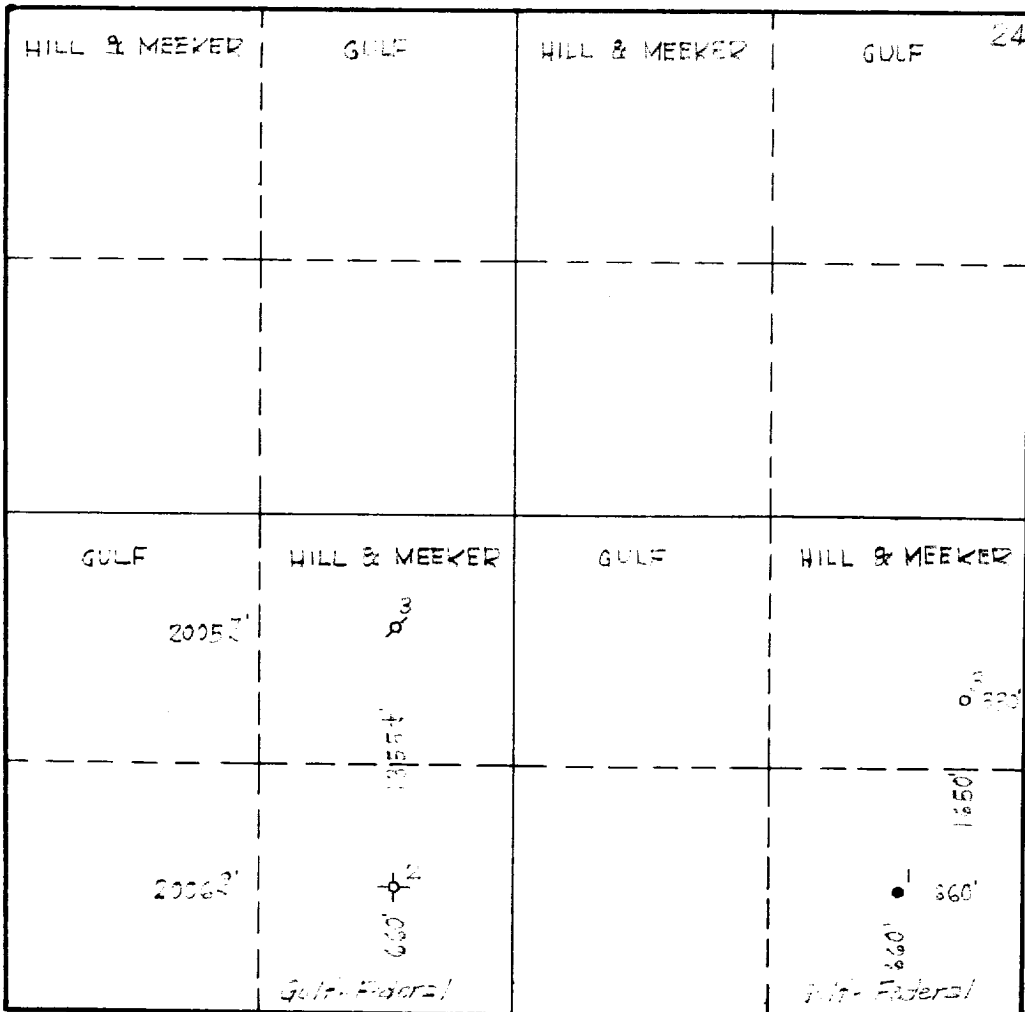

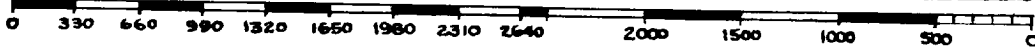
