NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this in triplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in E. C. Stephens "A" Well No. 1 in NW/4 of Sec. 13, T. 25S, R. 36E, N. M. P. M., Jal Oil Field, Lea County, N. M. May 4, 1934, 15-1/2 in. 70# lb. casing was cemented in Lime Sand formation at a depth of 467 feet on May 2, 1934, 280 sacks of El Tere cement was used.
