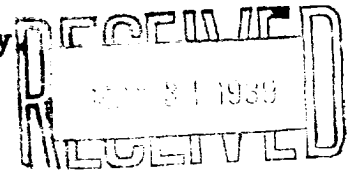

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Shot well with 280 quarts slodified glycerine with 9 4 1/2" x 9' 6" shells, 1 5" x 4' anchor shell, 1 3" x 3' Bomb shell

Top of shot @ 3472'. Bottom of shot 3540'. Increased production from 140 Bbls. to 407 bbls per day. Cleaned out and fished out tools 27 days.
