November 12th well was acidized with 1000 gallons Dowell "XI". Immediately after treatment started pumping on down. Pumped 24 bbls. oil load and acid in 7 hours the 12th. Pumped 124 bbls. oil, estimated 104 bbls. water in 24 hours 12th. Pumped 27 bbls. oil, estimated 27 bbls. water in 24 hours 14th. 15th pumped 42 bbls. oil, estimated 14 bbls. water in 24 hours. Pumped 29 bbls. oil & 29 bbls. water in 24 hours 16th. 17th pumped 47 bbls. oil & 47 bbls. water in 24 hours.

Before the treatment the well produced an average 27 bbls. oil, 27 bbls. water in 24 hours.
