As requested we are resubmitting Gulf Oil Corporation's request of 2-21-78 asking for administrative approval for an unorthodox location in a 80 acre standard proration unit in the Fowler Upper Yeso Pool for our S. J. Carr No. 7, located 2100' FSL and 1650' FWL of Section 10, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

1. This application is in the interest of conservation and prevention of waste.
2. Well No. 7 is located on the same 80 acre proration unit as S. J. Carr No. 5; however, Well No. 5 is incapable of producing top allowable production.
3. The recompletion of Well No. 7 in the Fowler Upper Yeso Pool represents a reasonable development of this pool.
4. The attached plat shows the proposed unorthodox location in the 80 acre standard proration unit and wells outlined.
5. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application by certified mail.
