Dear Mr. Lowe,

Pursuant to Division Rules 19.15.16.15(C)(6) and 19.15.15.13(C)-(D) NMAC, Longfellow Energy, L.P. ("Longfellow") requests administrative approval of a nonstandard location for the above-referenced oil well in an approximately 147-acre spacing unit, more or less, within an irregular section, as described more fully below.

The standard setback in the horizontal plane from any point in the completed interval to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit is 330 feet for an oil well. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(a) NMAC. The completed interval of the above-referenced well, however, will be 205 feet at its closest point from the southern boundary of the spacing unit. Longfellow is requesting approval to decrease the setback for the completed interval of the above-referenced well.

The proposed surface and bottom hole locations and first and last take points are as follows:

- 1. SHL: 1565' FSL and 675' FEL of Section 13-T17S-R28E
- 2. FTP: 1525' FSL and 100' FWL of Section 18-T17S-R29E
- 3. LTP: 1540' FSL and 100' FEL of Section 18-T17S-R29E

4. BHL: 1540' FSL and 20' FEL of Section 18-T17S-R29E

It is Longfellow's responsibility as a prudent operator to maximize the recovery of oil and gas reserves left in the ground. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow Longfellow to use its preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby maximize recovery and prevent waste.

Attached is the C-102 form and map indicating the offset tracts to assist the Division in its review of Longfellow's request. Longfellow has sent notice to all affected persons on the enclosed spreadsheet by certified mail, return receipt requested, with a copy of this request, the plat, and the C-102. The notice also informs the affected persons that, if they object to the aforementioned requests, they must file the objection in writing with the Division within 20 days from the date the Division receives this administrative approval request. I attach a sample of the notice letter and a spreadsheet with the types of interests and names of the affected parties, the location of each parties' interest, the date the letter was sent, and the mail tracking number for the mailings that went out today.



This Gas Capture Plan outlines actions to be taken by the Operator to reduce well/production facility flaring/venting for new completion (new drill, recomplete to new zone, re-frac) activity.

Gathering System and Pipeline Notification

Well(s) will be connected to a production facility after flowback operations are complete, if gas transporter system is in place. The gas produced from production facility is not yet dedicated, but will be connected to a 3rd party gathering system located in Eddy County, New Mexico. Gas will most likely be piped 100 yards east to Longfellow's Phillips AID State 4 (I-13-17s-28e) which is connected with DCP Operating Company, LP (36785). Operator will provide (periodically) to Gas Transporter a drilling, completion and estimated first production date for wells that are scheduled to be drilled in the foreseeable future. In addition, Operator and Gas Transporter have periodic conference calls to discuss changes to drilling and completion schedules. Gas from these wells will be processed at an unknown Processing Plant located in Eddy County, New Mexico. The actual flow of the gas will be based on compression operating parameters and gathering system pressures.

Flowback Strategy

After the fracture treatment/completion operations, well(s) will be produced to temporary production tanks and gas will be flared or vented. During flowback, the fluids and sand content will be monitored. When the produced fluids contain minimal sand, the wells will be turned to production facilities. Gas sales should start as soon as the wells start flowing through the production facilities, unless there are operational issues on <u>Gas Transporter</u> system at that time. Based on current information, it is <u>Operator's</u> belief the system can take this gas upon completion of the well(s).

Safety requirements during cleanout operations from the use of underbalanced air cleanout systems may necessitate that sand and non-pipeline quality gas be vented and/or flared rather than sold on a temporary basis.

Alternatives to Reduce Flaring

Below are alternatives considered from a conceptual standpoint to reduce the amount of gas flared.

- Power Generation On lease
 - o Only a portion of gas is consumed operating the generator, remainder of gas will be flared
- Compressed Natural Gas On lease
 - o Gas flared would be minimal, but might be uneconomical to operate when gas volume declines
- NGL Removal On lease
 - o Plants are expensive, residue gas is still flared, and uneconomical to operate when gas volume declines


