Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (OGRID No. 4323), pursuant to Division Rules 19.15.16.15(C)(6) and 19.15.15.13 NMAC and applicable rules governing acreage and well location requirements for the WC-025 G-07 S243225C; LWR Bone Spring pool [97964] and WC-025 G-06 S253209L; Bone Spring pool [96715], seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **CO Grizzly 34 27 Fed Com 408H well** (API No. 30-025-49722), in a 640-acre, more or less, spacing unit underlying the E/2 of Sections 27 and 34, T24S, R32E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The proposed location is as follows:

- Surface location: 192' FNL and 1625' FEL (Unit B) of Section 3
- Bottom hole location: 25' FNL and 1430' FEL (Unit B) of Section 27
- First take point: 25' FSL and 1430' FEL (Unit O) of Section 34
- Last take point: 100' FNL and 1430' FEL (Unit B) of Section 27

Since this acreage is governed by the Division’s statewide rules, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than the standard offsets to the southern boundary of the spacing unit – thus encroaching on the N/2NE/4 of Section 3, T25S, R32E. Approval of the unorthodox, completed interval will allow Chevron to use its preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area, which will maximize recovery and prevent waste.

**Exhibit A** are Form C-102s showing the proposed CO Grizzly 34 27 Fed Com 408H well encroaches on the spacing unit/tracts to the south in the N/2NE/4 of Section 3, T25S, R32E.

**Exhibit B** is a plat showing the proposed CO Grizzly 34 27 Fed Com 408H well in relation to adjoining spacing unit/tracts to the south. Exhibit B also identifies the ownership of the affected spacing unit, showing that it is owned by Chevron U.S.A. Inc. as 100% working interest owner. In addition, the exhibit identifies that these are BLM leases. Accordingly, the “affected persons”<sup>1</sup> are the applicant, Chevron U.S.A. Inc., and the United States Bureau of Land Management.

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
