El Paso Natural Gas Company (EPNG) is submitting the following report as requested in EPNG's 120-day Temporary Permit (Permit No. HBP-44). The report summarizes each test of new pipe, with less than 25,000 gallons per hydrostatic test event that occurred **between February 7, 2023 and June 16, 2023**.

- Project Description: EPNG replaced approximately 260 feet of new 26" O.D. pipe on Line No. 1100 between Milepost 341+2920 and Milepost 341+3165. The project was located in Hidalgo County, New Mexico.
- a. Location: Section 8, Township 23 South, Range 17 West;
- b. Date of the discharge was Monday June 6, 2023. The water was used as dust mitigation within the existing ROW;
- C. The volume of water discharged was approximately 7,000 gallons;
- d. The source of the water was from a municipal water supply from the City of Lordsburg.

In accordance with **EPNG's Permit HBP-44**, I would like to notify you of a planned hydrostatic test discharge on a small segment of *new* pipe required on **EPNG's Line No. 1100 Remediation Project in Hidalgo County, New Mexico**.

Project Description: Hydrostatically pressure test approximately 260 feet of new 26" O.D. pipe between Milepost 341+2920 (Anomaly Dig No. 4) and MP 341+3165 (Anomaly Dig No. 9). The discharge will occur near Anomaly Dig No. 9 located in Section 8, Township 23 South, Range 17 West of Hidalgo County. (Latitude = 32.31497389; Longitude = -108.61496984).

- Discharge will occur on Monday June 5, 2023.
- Amount of water required will be approximately 7,000 gallons.
- Source water will be from a municipal water supply from the City of Lordsburg.

*Upon completion, the water will be used for dust mitigation within the EPNG ROW, via a clean Water Truck.
