You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. 19.15.16.15(B)(1)(a) NMAC governs this proposed well and provides that the operator shall dedicate to each horizontal oil well a standard horizontal spacing unit that comprises of one or more contiguous tracts that the horizontal well's completed interval penetrates, each of which consists of a governmental quarter - quarter section or equivalent. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(a) NMAC governs the distance in the horizontal plane from any point in the completed interval to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit, measured along a line perpendicular to the completed interval or to the tangent thereof, shall be a minimum of 330 feet for an oil well. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(b) NMAC governs the first and last take point of a horizontal

well shall be no closer than 100 feet in the horizontal plane, to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit.

The request to deviate from an orthodox location has met all requirements of 19.15.16.15 (C)(5)(a) NMAC. It is understood that you are seeking this exception in order to create a non-standard location, comprised of Take Points referenced above, within the described Horizontal Spacing Unit.

This well's completed interval is as close as 100 feet to the northern edge of the horizontal spacing unit. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 36, encroachment to the S/2 N/2  
Section 35, encroachment to the S/2 N/2

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in 19.15.2.7(A)(8) NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

Division understands you are seeking this unorthodox location in order to locate the maximum production of resources, while preventing waste and protecting the correlative rights within the Wolfcamp formation underlying the S/2 of Section 36 and the S/3 of Section 35.

Devon Energy Production Company, LP, ("Devon"), OGRID No. 6137, is seeking administrative approval of an unorthodox well location ("NSL") for the Tambora 36-35 Fed Com 622H Well (the "622H Well") (API No. 30-015-Pending) to be completed within the WC 20S29E23; Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98357), an oil pool, underlying the S/2 of Sections 35 and 36, all in Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. A C-102 for the Well is attached as Exhibit A. This is a horizontal well that will be drilled as follows:

- Surface Location (SL): 1253' from the North line and 21' from the East line (Unit A) of Section 36, Township 20 South, Range 29 East;
- Bottom Hole Location (BHL): 2475' from the South line and 20' from the West line (Unit L) of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 29 East;
- First Take Point (FTP): 100' from the East line and 2475' from the South line (Unit I) of Section 36, Township 20 South, Range 29 East;
- Last Take Point (LTP): 100' from the West line and 2475' from the South line (Unit L) of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 29 East.



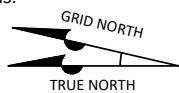

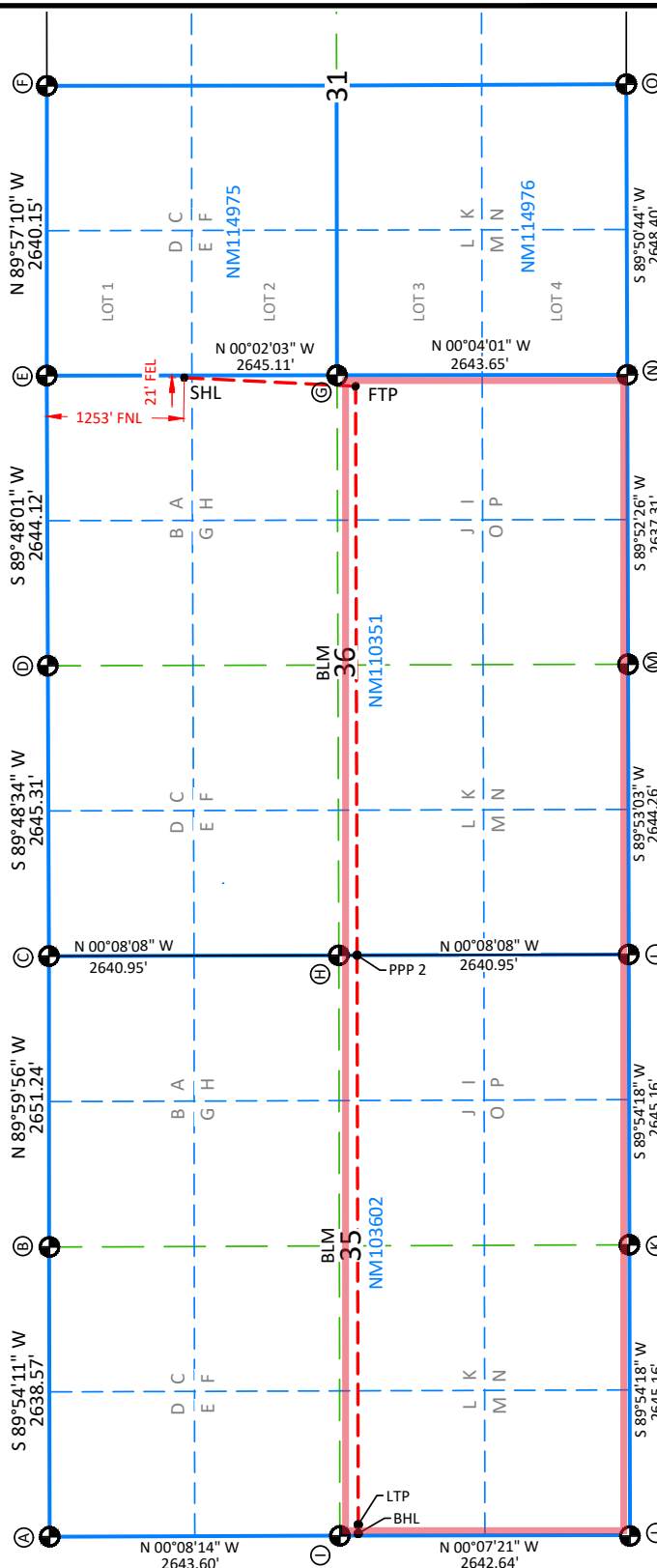

Dear Mr. Lowe,

Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. ("Devon") respectfully requests administrative approval of a non-standard location for the Tambora 36-35 Fed Com 622H well referenced above by decreasing the standard perpendicular setback distance from 330 feet in order to accommodate the lateral's non-standard distance from the north outer boundary of the unit. The well is located in the WC 20S29E23; Wolfcamp (Pool Code 98357), an oil pool built on 40-acre blocks. It is Devon's responsibility as a prudent operator to locate the lateral for maximum production and to minimize reserves left in the ground. Based on Devon's anticipated offset operations and overall spacing and staggering development plan within Sections 36 and 35, Devon finds that the proposed location for the 622H is the optimal location for producing the unit. Devon has notified the offset owners of the tracts upon which the well encroaches, and Devon respectfully submits that it has located the lateral in a manner that will increase ultimate recovery of reserves and thereby prevent waste of natural resources.

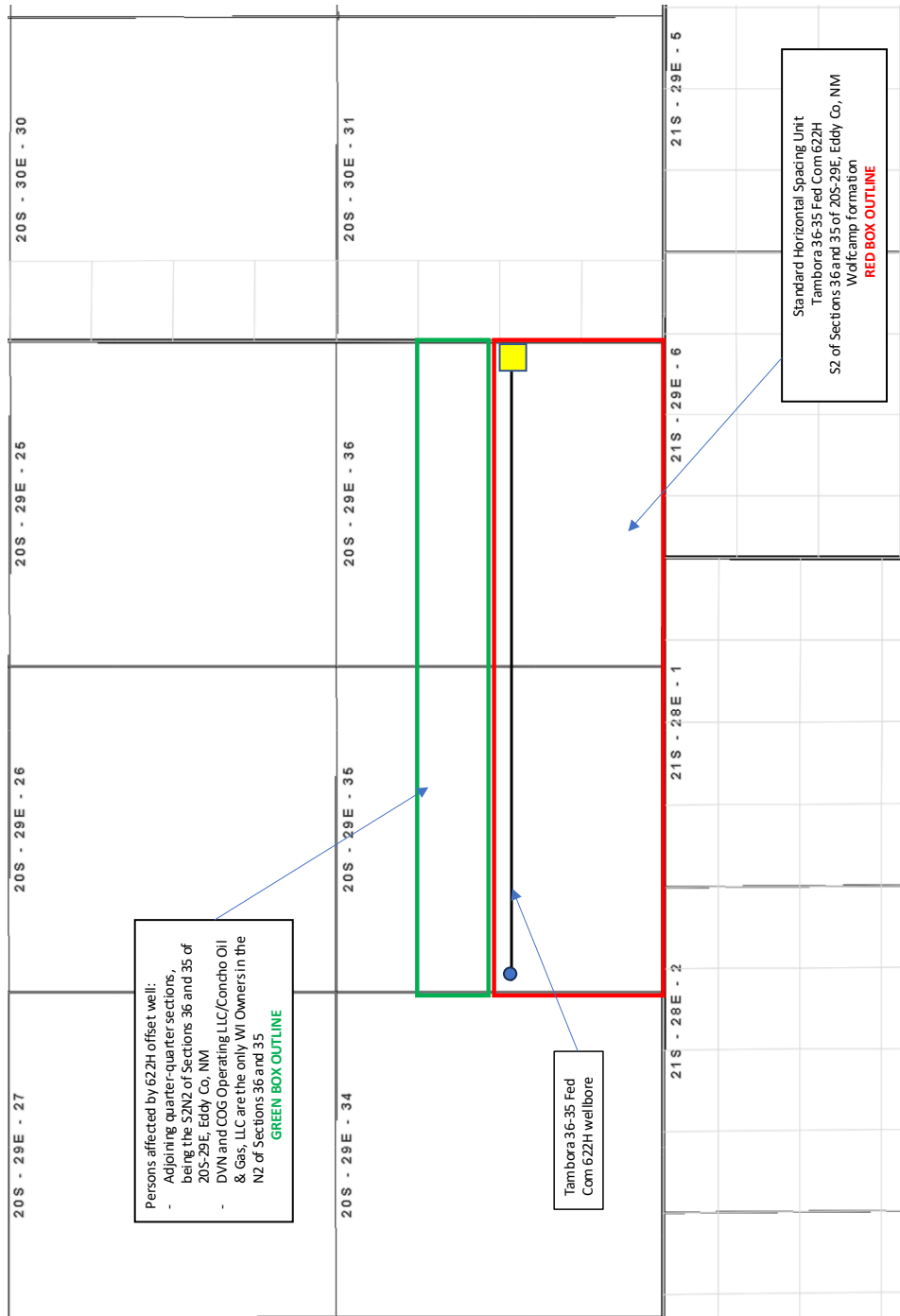
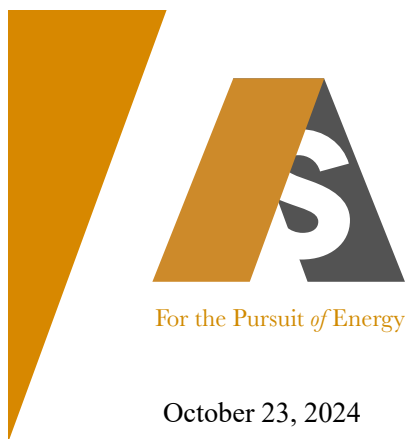
