You have requested to complete this horizontal well described above in the referenced pool or formation. This well is governed by special rules R-14262, for the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool and governs wells to be located at least 330 feet from the unit outer boundary of a spacing unit and no closer than 10 feet to any quarter – quarter section line. The completed intervals of horizontal wells are to be located no closer than 330 feet to the exterior boundary of a standard 320 - acre spacing unit.

The request to deviate from an orthodox location has met all requirements of 19.15.16.15 (C)(5)(a) NMAC. It is understood that you are seeking this exception in order to create a non-standard

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location, comprised of First and Last Take Points referenced above within the described Horizontal Spacing Unit.

The request to deviate from an orthodox location has met all requirements of 19.15.16.15 (C)(5)(a) NMAC. It is understood that you are seeking this exception in order to create a non-standard location, comprised of Take Points referenced above, within the described Horizontal Spacing Unit.

This well's completed interval is as close as 100 feet to the northern and southern edge of the horizontal spacing unit. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 11, encroachment to the SE/4  
Section 23, encroachment to the NE/4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in 19.15.2.7(A)(8) NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

The Division understands you are seeking this unorthodox location in order to maximize the lateral length of the well and to minimize reserves left in the ground thus increasing ultimate recovery of reserves within the Wolfcamp formation underlying the E/2 Section 14, thereby maximizing recovery of resources and preventing waste.

Your application has been filed under 19.15.16.15(C)(6) NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12 (A)(2) NMAC.

Per 19.15.15.13 (B) NMAC, **Division approves this unorthodox location.**

Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado (“Cimarex”), OGRID No. 162683, is seeking administrative approval of an unorthodox well location (“NSL”) for the Riverbend 14 Federal Com 4H Well (the “4H Well”) (API No. Pending) to be completed within the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool (Pool Code 98220), underlying a standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. A C-102 for the 4H Well is attached as Exhibit A. This is a U-lateral well that will be drilled as follows:

- Surface Location (SL): 264’ from the South line and 1,800’ from the West line (Unit N) of Section 11, Township 25 South, Range 28 East;
- Bottom Hole Location (BHL): 100’ from the North line and 990’ from the East line (Unit A) of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 28 East;
- First Take Point (FTP): 100’ from the North line and 2,310’ from the East line (Unit B) of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 28 East;
- Last Take Point (LTP): 100’ from the North line and 990’ from the East line (Unit A) of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 28 East.

Cimarex has included as Exhibit B, a letter explaining why this application is needed. This well will produce from the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) (Pool Code 98220). The special Division rules for the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool establish 330' foot setback requirements which are laid out in Order No. R-14262. The first and last take points for the proposed well are closer than 330' from the boundary of the spacing unit.

The unorthodox location will encroach towards the SE/4 of Section 11, all in Township 25 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Cimarex attests that, on or before submission of this application, it provided notice to the affected persons in the adjoining horizontal spacing unit which covers the SE/4 of Section 11, all in Township 25 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; said notice as described satisfies all provisions of 19.15.4.12A (2) NMAC; copies of the application and required plat maps were furnished. Cimarex has also provided notice to the Bureau of Land Management to the extent that federal leases are involved, pursuant to 19.15.2.7A(8)(d) NMAC. Cimarex provides herein a sectional map of this area, attached as Exhibit C. Proof of mailing, along with a copy of the notice letter sent to listed affected persons and parties, is attached hereto as Exhibit D. The pooling case associated with this application is Case No. 25531.







The wells are located in the Purple Sage-Wolfcamp Gas Pool (Pool Code 98220). It is Cimarex's responsibility as a prudent operator to maximize lateral length and to minimize reserves left in the ground. Decreasing the first and last take points will increase the wells effective lateral length by 400 feet thereby increasing ultimate recovery of reserves and thereby preventing waste of natural resources.
