You have requested an exception pursuant to Rule 19.15.16.15(A)(3) NMAC, to approve a non-standard horizontal spacing unit consisting of the entire area described above as the horizontal spacing unit. The proposed horizontal spacing unit does not consist of a quarter - quarter section or equivalent in both sections, as required by Rule 19.15.16.15(B)(1)(C) NMAC.

We understand that you are seeking this exception for an allowance to create a non-standard horizontal spacing unit, comprised of the entire Proposed Horizontal Spacing Unit referenced above within Eddy County, New Mexico.

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (8) Subsection A of 19.15.2.7 NMAC, in all adjoining units which are being noticed.

You have requested this non-standard horizontal spacing unit as your preferred well spacing that is necessary to prevent waste within the **Corral Canyon; Bone Spring, South** formation underlying the W/2 Section 35. This unit is to withdraw resources from the following entire unit, W/2, Section 23, W/2 Section 26 and the W/2 Section 35.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 19.15.16.15(B)(5) NMAC, the above-described **non-standard horizontal spacing unit is hereby approved**. Further, the Applicant may add additional wells to the non-standard spacing unit, the well(s) must be in the same horizontal spacing unit and pool/formation. The new well's APD shall reference this NSP order number on Form C-102 with an adjacent letter stating this request.

("XTO") (OGRID No. 5380), pursuant to Division Rules 19.15.16.15(B)(5) and 19.15.15.11.B NMAC and applicable rules governing acreage and well spacing requirements for the Corral Canyon; Bone Spring, South [13354], seeks administrative approval of a non-standard 960-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 of Sections 23, 26, & 35, Township 25 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The non-standard spacing unit will be dedicated to the following wells:

- **Corral 23-35 Federal Com 104H** (API No. 30-015-56701)
- **Corral 23-35 Federal Com 106H** (API No. 30-015-56884)
