AFFIDAVIT OF TRAVIS MACHA IN SUPPORT OF CASE NO. 20659

Travis Macha, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

- 1. My name is Travis Macha. I work for COG Operating LLC ("COG") as a Landman.
- 2. I testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters on August 23, 2019 in Case No. 20659. My credentials as a petroleum landman were accepted by the Division and made a matter of record at said hearing.
- 3. At the hearing, the Examiner requested I supplement my testimony with information pertaining to COG's communication with OXY USA WTP LP; Occidental Permian LP; Occidental Permian Ltd; OXY Y-1 Company (collectively "Oxy") and the status of Oxy's commitment to the Tomahawk WC Federal Exploratory Unit ("Unit").
- 4. COG personnel in each the Asset and Business Development Departments at COG have been communicating with OXY since mid-May regarding trade options for various acreage located in New Mexico, inclusive of acreage included in the Unit, which would result in greater percentage commitment to the Unit to COG.
- 5. In support of this, attached hereto as COG Supplemental Exhibit A is an exhibit prepared under my supervision and direction that summarizes COG's communication with OXY

either by email, telephone, or in person meetings, all which involved acreage located in the Unit. Attached to this Exhibit are copies of all the email communications between personnel at COG and personnel at Oxy. Information covered by Confidentiality Agreements in place between COG and Oxy has been redacted from the emails in compliance with said agreements. In addition, at Oxy's request, all of the names of Oxy's personnel have also been redacted.

- 6. Based on COG's communication with Oxy and other working interest owners in the Unit, COG anticipates having over 85% commitment to the Unit by the time COG applies to the BLM and State Land Office for final approval of the Unit, which is what is required under applicable federal regulations. Under the regulations, 85% commitment is not required prior to the NMOCD Hearing or at other preliminary stages of federal exploratory unit formation.
- 7. In my opinion, COG has made good faith efforts with all working interest owners in the Unit to reach voluntary joinder of their interest to the Unit Agreement.
