## **APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASES**

In Case No. 22142, Devon seeks an order (1) creating to the extent necessary a standard 640-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 of Sections 15 and 22, Township 25 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation, designated as a gas pool, underlying

said unit. Devon proposes to dedicate the unit to four initial wells: the Shire 22-15 Fed Com 613H Well, Shire 22-15 Fed Com 618H Well, Shire 22-15 Fed Com 718H Well, and Shire 22-15 Fed Com 733H Well.

Devon dedicates the **Shire 22-15 Fed Com 613H Well** (API 30-015-47328) horizontally drilled from a surface location in SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 22 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 15.

Devon dedicates the **Shire 22-15 Fed Com 618H Well** (API 30-015-47282) horizontally drilled from a surface location in SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 22 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 15.

Devon dedicates the **Shire 22-15 Fed Com 718H Well** (API 30-015-47330) horizontally drilled from a surface location in SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 22 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 15.

Devon dedicates the **Shire 22-15 Fed Com 733H Well** (API 30-015-47361) horizontally drilled from a surface location in SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 22 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 15.

The wells have nonstandard locations, as the take points are 100' from the outer boundary of the unit. NSL applications for these wells have been submitted to and approved administratively by the Division.
