APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2NW/4 of Section 29 and Lot 2, S/2NE/4, and SE/NW/4 (the S/2N/2) of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the S/2NW/4 of Section 29 and the S/2N/2 of Section 30, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant has drilled the Pavo Frio 29-30 B2FE Fed. Com. Well No. 1H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, and has dedicated the S/2NW/4 of Section 29 and the S/2N/2 of Section 30 to the well. The well is a horizontal well, with a first take point in the SE/4NW/4 of Section 29 and a last take point in Lot 2 of Section 30.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other interest owners in the S/2NW/4 of Section 29 and the S/2N/2 of Section 30 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, a certain Record Title Owner has failed or refused to join in dedicating his interest. SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF TYLER JOLLY

Tyler Jolly deposes and states:

- 1. I am a landman for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne"), and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have been qualified by the Division as an expert petroleum landman.
- 2. Pursuant to Division Rules, the following information is submitted in support of the compulsory pooling application:
 - (a) The purpose of this application is to force pool a Record Title owner of a federal lease into the horizontal spacing unit described below, and in the well drilled in the unit.
 - (b) No opposition is expected because the interest owner being pooled is deceased.
 - (c) A Form C-102 outlining the unit being pooled is submitted as Attachment A. Mewbourne seeks an order pooling of an uncommitted interest owner in the Bone Spring formation in a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2NE/4 of Section 29 and the S/2N/2 of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, for the Pavo Frio 29/30 B2FE Fed. Com. Well No. 1H.
 - (d) There is no depth severance in the Bone Spring formation.
 - (e) The person being pooled is W.T. Wynn, the Record Title owner of Federal Lease NM 056427, who is deceased. He owns 100% of Record Title to the lease, but no working interest in the Bone Spring formation.
 - (f) Mewbourne submitted a communitization agreement for the well unit to the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"), but it was returned unapproved because a signature for Mr. Wynn was unobtainable. The BLM requires a force pooling order to cure this defect. Attachment B.

- (g) Exhibit C contains a letter to the party being pooled, requesting approval of the communitization agreement. The letter was returned as undeliverable.
- (h) Because Mr. Wynn is not a working interest owner, Mewbourne does not request approval of an AFE, overhead rates, or a risk charge.
- (i) Mewbourne requests that it be designated operator of the well.
- (j) The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me or under my supervision, or compiled from company business records.
- (k) The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.
- 3. I understand that this Self-Affirmed Statement will be used as written testimony in this case. 
